A By-Law of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews to amend By-Law No. 3293.

WHEREAS Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 3293 set out certain locations in the Municipality where parking is prohibited.

AND WHEREAS Council are desirous of adding to the list of areas defined.

THEREFORE, the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 3293 be amended by adding the following road to the prohibited areas;
 - a) The north side of Sawchuk Drive from PTH #9A, 0.25 km. west.
 - b) All Public Reserves within the R.M. of St. Andrews.

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ST. ANDREWS
BY-LAW NO. 3806

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews to amend Parking Control By-law No. 3293 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS By-Law No. 3293 and amendments thereto set amount of fine to be paid in the event of violations of the by-law and amendments thereto and also define certain locations in the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews where vehicle parking is prohibited;

AND WHEREAS Council is of the opinion that the amount and manner of collection of the fine be revised and that additional locations in the Municipality should be designated as where is prohibited.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Rural Municipality of Andrews in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. Paragraph 17(c) of By-Law No. 3680, being an amendment to Paragraph 17 of By-law 3293, be and is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefore.

17(c) That the owner or operator receiving the parking tag may report with such parking tag to the Municipal offices of the Rural Municipality St. Andrews and pay to the Secretary/Treasurer or other person assigned by him to such duties as penalty for the contravention of this by-law the sum of \$25.00.

2. THAT Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 3293 be amended by the following locations to the prohibited areas:

A. ALL THOSE PORTIONS OF LYLE DRIVE LOCATED TO THE EAST OF THE EASTERN LIMIT OF SEAGULL DRIVE AS SHOWN ON PLAN 20867, WLTO AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE SAID SEAGULL DRIVE AND LYLE DRIVE AND TO THE WEST OF THE WESTERLY LIMIT OF RIVER ROAD AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH LYLE DRIVE AND THE SAID RIVER ROAD.

B. ALL OF SUNRISE BAY AS SHOWN ON PLAN 20867, WLTO

C. ALL OF SEAGULL DRIVE AS SHOWN ON THE SAID PLAN.

3. THAT the proper officers of the Rural Municipality Andrews are hereby authorized and directed to do all things for the proper implementation of the provisions of this By-law.



AND WHEREAS Council is of the opinion that additional locations
should be designated

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews
in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. THAT Schedule "A" of By-law No. 3293 be amended by adding the
following locations to the prohibited areas:

The South side of Ralph Avenue commencing at a point
fifty (50) feet west of the turn-around and including
that portion of the turn-around located in the Rural
Municipality of St. Andrews in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2-17-4E.

The South side of Kernstead Road commencing at a point
five hundred (500) feet west of eastern end.

Both sides of Grant Street between PR#232 (Matlock
Road) and Daniel Avenue in the part of Matlock located
in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 10-17-4E, in the Rural Municipality of
St. Andrews.

Both sides of Riverview Street between PR#410
(St. Andrews Road) and Captain Kennedy Road.

2. THAT the proper officers of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews
are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary for the proper
implementation of the provisions of the By-law.

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ST. ANDREWS

BY-LAW NO. 3680

Being a By-law of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews to amend By-law No. 3293 as amended by By-law No. 3306.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the best interests of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews to amend By-Law No. 3293, as hereinafter provided;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of St. Andrews in Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. Paragraph 17 of By-Law No. 3293 is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:

"17 (a) Any Peace Officer or other person appointed to enforce this By-law may issue a notice in a form approved by the Secretary-Treasurer, hereinafter referred to as a "Parking Tag" to any person who has contravened provisions of this By-Law.

(b) The said Parking Tag shall set out the Provincial Registration No. of the motor vehicle, the time at which the vehicle was parked in contravention of this By-Law, and any other facts, the knowledge of which is necessary to a thorough understanding of the circumstances of the contravention and such Parking Tag shall be attached to the vehicle or handed to the owner or operator should that person be present at that time.

(c) The owner or operator receiving the Parking Tag may, within 20 days from the date on which the Parking Tag is attached to the motor vehicle or handed to the owner or operator, report with such Parking Tag to the municipal offices of the Municipality of St. Andrews and pay to the Secretary-Treasurer or other person assigned by him to such duty the penalty for the contravention of this By-Law. If the owner or operator reports as above within the first 11 days from the date on which the Parking Tag was attached to the Motor Vehicle or handed to the owner or operator the amount of the fine to be paid shall be \$10.00. If the owner or operator of the motor vehicle reports as above between the 12th to 20th day from the day on which the Parking Tag was attached to the motor vehicle or handed to the owner or operator the amount of the fine to be paid shall be \$20.00.

(d) Any person being the owner or operator of a motor vehicle in respect of which a Parking Tag has been issued who wishes to plead not guilty to the contravention of this By-Law shall appear before a Magistrate at the Provincial Court Office in the Town of Selkirk in Manitoba between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M. on any work day within 20 days from the date on which the Parking Tag was attached to the motor vehicle or handed to the owner or operator.

(e) Any person being the owner or operator of a motor vehicle in respect of which a Parking Tag has been issued who fails to either report to the Municipal Office as set out above or appear before a Magistrate as set out above shall be liable to default conviction and upon failure to pay the fine resulting from the default conviction may be liable to a term of imprisonment.

A By-Law of The Rural Municipality of St. Andrews
for the regulating and controlling of parking upon
the highways of such Municipality.

* * * * *

The Rural Municipality of St. Andrews, in Council assembled,
enacts as follows:-

1. That this By-Law may be referred to as "The Parking By-Law".
2. Where used in this By-Law:-
 - (a) "Park" when prohibited means to stand a vehicle whether occupied or not, except
 - (i) when it is caused to stand temporarily for the purpose of, and while actually engaged in loading or unloading; or
 - (ii) in obedience to a peace officer or a traffic control device;and "parking" has a corresponding meaning. For the purposes of any provision of this by-law restricting parking to a specified number of consecutive minutes or other interval, unless a vehicle is moved at least through the nearest intersection it shall be deemed to have remained stationary.
 - (b) "Vehicle" means a device, in, upon, or by which a person or thing is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except a device designed to be moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.
 - (c) All other terms used in this By-Law shall have the same meaning as similar terms used in "The Highway Traffic Act" S.M. 1966 c. 29, s. 1.

This is Schedule "A" to the Parking By-Law being By-Law No. 3293
of The Rural Municipality of St. Andrews.

Note: (This schedule is referred to in Section 16 of said By-Law
which section prohibits parking at the location named in
Schedule "A".)

The locations named herein are:

1. Along the west side of the River Road from the Southern boundary of River Lot 103 Parish of St. Andrews to the Northern boundary of River Lot 105 Parish of St. Andrews, then along both sides of the River Road from the Southern limit of River Lot 106 Parish of St. Andrews extending Northerly and Westerly to the junction of the River Road and P.T.H. No. 9 in River Lot 117, Parish of St. Andrews. BRIDGE
2. Both Sides of the Easterly 500 feet of the Road in River Lot 110, St. Andrews. (New LYALL DR Lockport School)
3. Both sides of the River Road from the Town of Selkirk south through the Parish of St. Clements to the junction of the River Road and P.T.H. No. 9 in Lot 1, Parish of St. Clements.
4. Both sides of the Ferry Road from the Red River to P.T.H. No. 9 in River Lot 120, St. Andrews.
5. Both sides of the Road Allowance between Section 36-14-4E and Section 1-15-4E for a distance of 300 feet on each side of the bridge across Muckle's Creek.
6. Both sides of the road beginning in River Lot 82 Parish of St. Peters which runs east to the Red River from the Main Highway Plan 3098, thence north and west to its junction with the same Main Highway in River Lot 86, Parish of St. Peters. PEERS + McIVER RDS.
7. Both sides of the Dominion Government Road Allowance which is the Western boundary of Plan 2424 in Section 23-15-4E for a distance of 300 feet north of Netly Creek. 4 WINDS RD.
8. Both sides of the Dominion Government Road Allowance East of Section 15-15-4E for a distance of 300 feet north of Wavey Creek. BOYD SOUTH AT WAVEY CR. (SOUTH OF OLD KIRKNESS RESIDENCE)
9. Both sides of the Dominion Government Road Allowance west of the North half of Section 1-15-4E COUTURE RD.

3. No vehicle shall be parked in front of a fire station, whether on the same or opposite side of the street.
4. No vehicle shall be parked on the same side of the street as and directly opposite a church or other place of worship.
5. No vehicle shall be parked on the same side of the street as, and within fifty feet of, an entrance to a school ground, at any time between the hours of nine a.m. and five p.m. on any days excepting Saturdays and Sundays and excepting during the months of July and August in each year.
6. No vehicle shall be parked in a lane.
7. No vehicle shall be parked on a street between the hours of three o'clock a.m., and seven o'clock a.m., of any day.
8. Excepting while complying with a traffic control device no vehicle shall remain standing at the curb within twenty-five feet of an intersection or within fifteen feet of a hydrant.
9. No vehicle shall be parked in a street so as to obstruct the entrance to a lane or to a driveway or approach leading into private premises.
10. No vehicle shall stop with its left side to the curb, except on a one way street in which parking is permitted on both sides.
11. No vehicle shall stand backed up to the curb except when actually loading or unloading, but no vehicle shall stand so backed up if it interferes with or interrupts the passage of other vehicles or street cars.
12. No person shall park an advertising vehicle, or a vehicle displayed for sale.
13. Except while complying with a traffic control device or the Provisions of The Highway Traffic Act, no person shall bring any vehicle to a stop and permit it to remain standing abreast of another vehicle standing in a highway.
14. No vehicle shall be parked on any street other than parallel with the curb, headed in the direction of traffic, with the curb-side wheels of the vehicle within one foot of the curb, and a clear space of three feet

left ahead and behind.

15. Where the roadway or pavement on any street does not exceed twenty-four feet in width, no person shall park or permit any vehicle to remain standing on the side of such roadway or pavement, immediately opposite to, or within twenty feet, of another vehicle already parked or standing on the other side thereof.

16. No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended at any of the locations named in Schedule "A" to this By-Law.

Any person found guilty of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction therefor shall be liable to a penalty of not more than Fifty Dollars and costs, and in default of immediate payment of the said penalty and costs to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days.~~

18. That By-Laws Nos. 2131 and 2576 are hereby repealed.
